
PEOPLE

HOME MISSION: Giving from Central Baptist Association churches to the Home Mission appeal amounted to £222.313 to the end of September, with the 2015 equivalent figure being £203.790. (This represents about two-thirds of the anticipated total donations to 2016 Home Mission target for Central and, as with most of the country, a lot of donations arrive in the last three months).

INSURANCE COVER FOR CHURCH MEMBERS: We have recently received a numbers of calls from churches asking about insurance cover for church members. If your church is insured with Baptist Insurance then your church members will be covered under the Public Liability section of the policy. That means they are covered if a claim is made against them which arises from an incident that happened whilst they were acting on behalf of the church. It is important to bear in mind that the cover only applies if the member was acting on behalf of the church and authorised to do so. For any incidents where a church member was acting in a private capacity they would not be covered. You can check whether your church has liability cover by looking at your latest policy schedule or by contacting us on 0345 070 2223.
